Topic to discuss & Question of the week

WEEK 1:

**A Yid is forever,
Hashem is proud of me**

*Question: Which words in the Possuk tell us who will
have Techiyas Hameisim?*

Answer: Kol Yisroel- every Yid!

WEEK 2:

**We are Hashem's plant,
constantly growing**

*Question: What words in the Possuk mean
"Hashem's plant and handiwork"?*

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Week 1

A Yid is forever,
Hashem is proud of me

We say this Possuk in summer months before Pirkei Avos. This Possuk starts KOL YISROEL- every Yid is worthy of Techiyas Hameisim. Hashem is preparing a spot near the Tzaddikim, for me to be when Moshiach comes.

Have students think about something Gashmius. It can be a toy, money, food, etc.
Show them how Gashmius can break, lose value over time, or simply not last forever.

Explain how a Yid is different. We are a part of Hashem (He is our Father) and because Hashem is נצח, we are נצח. A Yid lasts forever- not only our neshama, also our guf. Even a Yid that passed away, his luz bone remains, and he will have techiyas hameisim when Moshaich comes.

Just like a baby doesn't do anything special to be loved by their parents, they are just automatically loved by being born a part of their parents, so too every Yid is loved by Hashem forever, even without doing anything special.

Hashem has Nachas from me just by being a Yid.
Of course, the Mitzvos I do, bring even MORE Nachas to Hashem. We'll learn more about that next week BEZH

Takeaway:

A Yid is forever!

Hashem is proud of me, and preparing a special place for me when Moshiach comes.

Week 2

I am Hashem's plant, constantly growing

Hands-on activity: Planting

Hashem compares every Yid to His handiwork, His plant, that He takes pride in.

Just like we care for our plant, with love and care, watching it grow, and we are so excited when it does, Hashem watches and protects me, and helps me grow to the best person I can be.

Our parents love us all the time, and when we do something special (like an extra surprise) it makes them even more proud! So too, Hashem is so proud of us just because we are His Yid, His child. And when we learn Torah and do Mitzvos, it makes Hashem even more proud!

The Yetzer Hara might say "have fun now, who cares?", but I know HASHEM cares! It's much more worth it to choose listening to Hashem- who is forever- over the Yetzer Hara, who will be gone when Moshiach comes!

Sometimes, I make a mistake and can feel really bad about myself. This Possuk helps me understand- a mistake is not something to feel bad about, it's an opportunity to grow!

When I do Teshuva, and commit to being better next time, Hashem is extra proud of me!

Takeaway:

I am Hashem's handiwork.

When I grow, Hashem is extra proud of me!

Mission:

I brought Nachas to Hashem today!
